Dear Judge Hochberg:

I am writing in my capacity as General Counsel for Dakota Drug, Inc., a pharmaceutical wholesaler based in Minot, North Dakota in support of the motion seeking final approval of the proposed settlement and fee award in the above-captioned litigation.

Dakota Drug is an absent class member in the above-described case, and I understand that Dakota Drug will have a claim to recovery out of the Settlement Fund in this case. Class Counsel has fully informed Dakota Drug of the facts and circumstances of the case, including the legal hurdles and other risks involved. Dakota Drug is satisfied that the proposed \$190 million case settlement is fair and adequate and that the proposed attorneys' fee award of one-third of the settlement amount is appropriate in this complex case.
