**DECLARATION OF NATALIE FINKELMAN BENNETT IN SUPPORT
OF PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES
AND CREATION OF A FUND FOR FUTURE LITIGATION EXPENSES**

I, Natalie Finkelman Bennett, declare as follows:

1. I am a member at the law firm of Shepherd, Finkelman, Miller & Shah, LLP. I submit this Declaration in support of Plaintiffs' Motion for Reimbursement of Expenses in connection with services rendered in prosecuting this action through trial.

2. My firm has acted as counsel to the End-Payor Class Plaintiffs in this litigation. During the course of this litigation, my firm was a member of the executive committee and has been involved in the following activities:
